

**MISSOURI PAINT HORSE CLUB
BREEDERS FUTURITY RULES 2010**

The Missouri Paint Horse Club Breeder's Futurity consists of four divisions:

Weanling at Halter

Early Colts-Geldings
Late Colts-Geldings
Early Fillies
Late Fillies

Yearlings at Halter

Yearling Stallions
Yearling Mares
Yearling Geldings

Yearling Longe Line

2 Year Old Western Pleasure

Entry Eligibility:

1. All horses entered must be the produce of a Missouri breeder's Futurity nominated stallion in the entrant's year of foaling.
 - A.) All stallions nominated to the futurity must be registered or listed in APHA, AQHA or JC.
 - B.) Late nominations will be accepted through August 15th at double the fee.
 - C.) The **nominator** of the stallion need NOT be the registered owner of the stallion or a member of the Missouri Paint Horse Club.
 - D.) 2010 Stallion Stimulus rule allows for all 2010 weanlings, yearlings and 2 year olds of any stallion whether nominated by paying the \$150 nominations fee.
 - E.) All horses entered must be registered with the American Paint Horse Association in either the regular or Solid Paint Bred.
 - F.) For the weanling division, the entry fee is divided into two payments with the first payment of \$50.00 being due on or before May 15th and the second payment of \$130.00 due on or before July 15th. For all other divisions, the entry deadline is July 15th at the normal fee of \$180.00. Late entries will be accepted until August 15th at a \$50.00 late entry fee. All entries must be accompanied by the horse's registration papers (in the case of weanlings, a work order number issued by APHA and identification of the foal is acceptable until August 15th, at which time registration papers must be in the futurity office).
 - G.) All horses shown must be entered in their respective open class, if offered. Solid Paint bred horses are required to pay a \$15.00 office fee in lieu of entry fee if no corresponding class offered. **ENTRIES ARE REQUIRED TO SHOW IN THE CORRESPONDING OPEN CLASS. 2 Year Old Pleasure entries are required to show to open judges A,B,C,D on Saturday to be eligible for futurity. Futurity judges for 2 Year Old Pleasure on Sunday will be E,F,G,H**
 - H.) Entries do not have to be shown in one division to be eligible for another. (Example: A horse need not be shown in the weanling or yearling division to be eligible to compete in the two year old western pleasure)
 - I.) All registered owners and exhibitors of entrants must be a member in good standing with the Missouri Paint Horse Club.
 - J.) All classes will be governed by the rules and regulations of the American Paint Horse Association and the Missouri Paint Horse Club.
 - K.) Futurity classes will be judged under 4 judges picked from the 8 available Labor Day POR judges. Low score will be thrown out and a tiebreaker judge will be used.

Prize Money:

1. The value of the Futurity prize money shall be the total amount of money paid in fees, less administrative costs, plus any added money as available.
2. All payments made by owners of horses entered in the four divisions of the Futurity will remain in the class in which each horse was entered in that year.
3. Payback will be figured as follows:

1-3	60%	40%				
4-6	50%	30%	20%			
7-9	40%	30%	20%	10%		
10-12	35%	25%	20%	14%	6%	
13-16	30%	25%	20%	14%	6%	5%

4. Prize money will be paid the day of the show. If for any reason the entry is found in violation of the rules of the American Paint Horse Association or the Missouri Paint Horse Club, the owner agrees to forfeit and return any prize money awarded.

Liability

There will be no refund of entry fee or substitutions allowed, regardless of the reason, unless the futurity is cancelled. The Futurity committee reserves the right to reject any entry from competition for failure to comply with the conditions of the MPHC Breeders Futurity.

The MPHC Breeders Futurity committee retains the right to make necessary adjustments, with board approval, to the futurity rules as to act in the best interest of the Futurity. The MPHC Breeders Futurity is held in conjunction with the MPHC Labor Day Week End Show at Sedalia, Missouri.
