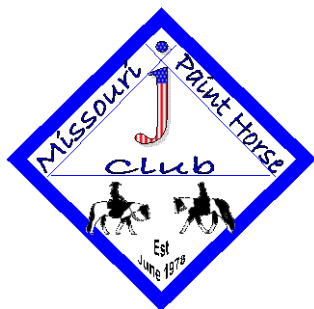


# MJPHC JANUARY 2011 NEWSLETTER
